He is the author of seventeen entries for the forthcoming *Mark Twain Encyclopedia*.

Professor Alice Hall Petry of the Rhode Island School of Design at Providence, RI will speak on *Cable, Twain, and The South*. The author of numerous scholarly books and articles, Professor Petry's presentation will deal primarily with the joint appearances of George Washington Cable and Mark Twain on the lecture platform as well as with their mutual interests such as Southern folklore, racial issues, and social reform.

Professor Joseph B. McCullough of the University of Nevada at Las Vegas will speak on *Mark Twain's Many Faces of Eve* under the auspices of the Center's Distinguished Academic Visitors program.
